Warmth for the inside, while the outside is cold

As I have been going outside the last few days, the temperature is surprising. In the coldest month for WI, it has been in the 30's. Not just that, but has been in the upper 30's. As I drove to the church today and looked around, I realized that a lot of the snow that had been on the ground - 17" or so, has almost all melted in various places. This is not only unusual, but also very unexpected.

In month where our temperatures are usually very low, yesterday it actually hit 40 degrees. Yet in 2023, the high was 9 degrees. That is a NORMAL temperature for January in WI.

Why do I share this? One, I want you to know how cold it gets here, and the normal temps. Two, I want to say how happy I am for the much warmer temperatures this year. Lastly, I want to point out the temperature of the day, has nothing to do with the temperature of our heart.

We are now in February, and on February 14th, we will celebrate Valentine's day. It is a day that focuses on love for others. Often we give cards, chocolates, or other gifts to the people we love and care about. But I want us to think about why and when we should be loving and not just on Feb. 14th, but also on every other day of the year.

In Matthew 22:36-40, we learn from Jesus the most important laws. There are two of them - love God and love people. On these two commands, all the rest of the law and the prophets hang. Again, they are loving God and loving others.

So, while the temperature in your home town may not be as cold as it usually is, or perhaps it is colder than usual, do not let the temperature outsider affect the temperature of your heart.

Make sure that you are thinking about God and loving Him. Thanking Him for creation, for your life, and for others around you. And I am sure that you can continue to add to this list.

But also be sure thank God that He not only gives you the ability to love Him, but also to love others as well. We all know that loving other people can be challenging. It is hard. But, do not let the challenge keep you from showing love to others. Don't let the cold from outside keep you from sharing the warmth on the inside.

As you may want it to be warmer - I do - remember that you have the ability to help others feel warm on the inside, by showing them love. Jesus also taught us this in John 15:12 My command is this: Love each other as I have loved you. (NIV) So, when we show and share the love of Jesus to others, we are helping others to feel the warmth not only of our love, but also the love of Jesus. May that be a part of our personal mission as we are moving from a colder outside to much warmer inside.
